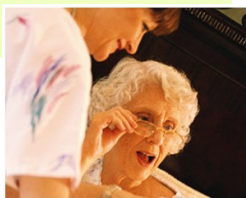

Class:

Wednesday/Thursday from 7:30 am-1:00 pm, and one additional day on Friday August 15th in NCC's state of the art nursing lab, in the hospital and in a long term care facility.
